

## New routines for deliveries of dangerous goods above 1 liter/kg



Campus management staff will make an assessment of deliveries of dangerous goods arriving at EBC based on the dangerous goods classification and the volume/weight of the content.

**Deliveries of dangerous goods (flammable goods/dangerous chemicals above 1 liter/kg) is made by campus management staff in the respective department solvent cabinet.**

The reason behind the direct delivery to the solvent cabinets is to reduce the risk of storing dangerous goods on the dropoff benches for labware placed in corridors. This applies to houses 5, 7, 17, 18 and 20.

The delivery is transported to the recipient's solvent cabinet by a pre-determined route where a minimum of students and staff are passing in order to minimize the risk of accidents and spill. Note that staff may not use the elevator together with the goods.

The goods are scanned by EBC package management software designed to assist the tracking of goods from the delivery central to the recipient.

Campus management staff will inform the recipient when the delivery of dangerous goods have been done by placing the delivery note together with a message on the recipient bench for labware and sending an e-mail to the recipient.
